REGULATIONS GEORGIA MOUNTAIN FAIR PARADE

- Parade begins forming at 9:30 a.m. behind the South State Bank
- Judging will begin promptly at 9:45 a.m. Those who wish to be judged must arrive prior to 9:30 a.m. If not, your float will not be judged.
- Floats should reflect the theme of the parade.
- Parade starting time: 10:55 a.m. rain or shine
- Moving and motorized vehicles of all types must be kept away from the horses.
- Position of entries in the parade will be determined by the Ga Mtn Fair Parade Committee.
- Parade marshals will maintain a 20-foot distance between entrants in order for the parade announcer to identify floats and category winners.
- Alcoholic beverages will not be permitted on the parade route or on the parade grounds. Violators will be referred to law enforcement officials. Motorized vehicles must keep in pace with the parade and will not be allowed to "stay back" and then use non-parade friendly speeds to catch up.

EXHIBITORS RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Send your application along with three 4x6 photographs including display of your works.
- 2. The review committee will consider all applications of **handcrafted items only**. Only items listed on application are to be offered for sale (new items must receive prior authorization).
- 3. Imports, kits & commercially produced items will not be allowed.
- 4. Exhibitors advertising discounted works such as "50% off" or "2 for the price of 1" strictly prohibited.
- 5. Upon acceptance, a non-refundable booth fee of \$400 is due. Do not mail any money until you receive an acceptance letter.
- 6. If you require receipt books, you will need to bring them, as the Georgia Mountain Fair will no longer provide them.
- 7. The craft committee will assign booths; every effort will be made to vary the type of craft by location to maximize sales.
- 8. Credit card service is available at the Craft Office for a fee of 5% per transaction (American Express, Discover, Master Card and Visa). The minimum charge purchase is \$10.
- 9. ALL BOOTHS MUST BE OPENED & MANNED DURING OPERATING HOURS.
- 10. GMF will provide twenty-four hour security, but is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
- 11. Nearby parking is provided for crafters. <u>Exhibitors must use designated parking areas</u>. Vehicles are strictly prohibited in the craft area during hours of operation.
- 12. Overt solicitation and selling items outside your area is not permitted.
- 13. Exhibitor's attire and behavior must adhere to the overall family-oriented theme of the show. The Georgia Mountain Fair reserves the right to determine what constitutes proper attire and behavior.
- 14. All booths are required to maintain a fire extinguisher at all times.
- 15. Booth alterations are strictly prohibited.
- 16. Promoter will have sole decision on acceptability of work and reserves the right to remove any items or signs from booths.
- 17. Violation of regulation may be adequate grounds for prompt closure of exhibit.
- 18. Exhibitors cannot sublet or apportion space to anyone else.
